

Blue & White Meeting Minutes

January 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:32 PM by Treasurer Ray Schwabenbauer. It was our understanding that Joe W. had resigned as president of Blue & White, but he did not submit a letter of resignation. Bill S. has agreed to take over the remainder of his term. A motion was made to approve the change of president (D. Brink, 2nd - D. Staub). The issue was tabled until the next meeting, pending official word on the resignation.

The minutes of the November 11, 2009 minutes were approved with the following correction: Ed & Patty *Shontz* were the ones being recognized at the previous meeting for raising money. (1st – C. Laverde, 2nd – D. Staub)

Treasurer's Report:

The report was given by Ray S. and was approved as written. (1st – C. Brozeski, 2nd – D. Brink)

Fundraising Report:

1. Fall Candle Sale

Profit was approximately \$4000; there are 5 cases left to sell at extra sporting events with SB approval. A total of 84 athletes sold candles, selling 895 items. A recommendation was made that we sell only in fall or in winter. Trying to span both seasons does not work with final game/ first practice dates and delivery deadlines for Christmas. It was also suggested that coaches might help to motivate sales by offering incentives to their team.

2. Basketball Tournament

Larry was not present at the meeting to give a report, but Katie K. thought that the profit was approximately \$3350.

3. Spring Candle Sale

We are looking at mid-March to begin the sale.

4. Turkey Bowl

The Turkey Bowl is scheduled for March 13th. The committee is meeting immediately after B&W tonight to finalize plans.

5. Track Invitational

There is no track coach yet, so no information is available. (Ronda D. not present)

Old Business:

Bill S. updated the group on winter sports programs. Programs were allocated to parent reps to be sold at each of the 4 winter sports: Wrestling- 30, Boys Basketball -20, Girls Basketball - 20, Swimming – 25. Programs are to be sold at \$3.00 each.

New Business:

1. C. Brozeski said she would meet with anyone (Ronda, anyone else) that would like to help with the track invitational. All of the information is on a computer and can be shown to them.
2. A fundraising matrix developed by D. Staub was presented to the group. Coaches were asked to review it and give their thoughts on it. Discussion included the idea that sports who were involved should be a part of the fundraiser (i.e. the track invitational should include track people). Even though a sport is in charge of organizing a fundraiser, all sports are still responsible for participating in order to earn their allotment. This resulted in the development of a list of each sport that will be responsible for a set fundraiser from year to year, rather than rotating the responsibility or just asking for volunteers. B&W board members will contact reps from the sports that are not present and let them know what slots still need filled. The list will be printed and e-mailed upon approval.
3. Website maintenance
Bob Rupert (baseball) volunteered to take care of this.
4. The baseball coach asked that a few individual fundraisers be approved. He was asked to submit the request to the B&W board in writing.
5. C. Brozeski will send charges for senior photos to Ray and he will submit the bills to coaches to approve.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 3rd in the HS Cafeteria.
