

Blue & White Boosters Meeting Minutes Wednesday, March 3, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:37 PM by Vice President Paul S. A special vote was held and Bill Sundo was unanimously voted in as President of Blue & White, to replace Joe W.

The minutes of the January 13, 2010 were handed out and approved as read. (1st- Larry E., 2nd Dorothy S.)

Treasurer's Report

Ray S. handed out general reports and individual coaches reports. The current balance including both the checking account and insured money fund is \$92,133.04

Fundraising reports

1. Turkey Bowl

Wendy M. gave the report. Tickets are still available for the Turkey Bowl on March 13th; the committee is currently working on getting more donations from businesses. She stressed that volunteers are the key to the success of the Turkey bowl, so coaches need to get their volunteers and sports baskets together by the middle of next week.

2. Spring Candle Sale

Forms are ready to be handed out to spring sports. The order forms will be due April 12th with an expected candle delivery date of May 11th.

3. Track Invitational

Rick F. (AD) has already sent out invitations to schools via the group e-mail for the AD's in district 10. 30 schools in Clarion county have also been contacted, as well as several in the Pittsburgh area via the Hickory AD. Rick F., Cindy B., Bill S., and Therese S. will be heading up the committee. A meeting will take place as soon as the Turkey bowl is over; the date of the invitational is May 1st, 2010.

Old Business

1. Bill recognized the new coaches that were present (swimming, track) and mentioned that we will be looking for more involvement from coaches.

2. The proposed fundraising matrix was presented. Cross country & Girl's Basketball agreed to help with the \$100 raffle. Soccer and softball will be contacted by Bill S. to get the sports program together next year. Tennis volunteered to help with the fall candle sale. Bill asked for objections but decided not to vote & just accept the matrix as written otherwise.

New Business

1. Rick F. was asked to update the group on sports – he addressed renovations that have taken place and plans for the future including;
 - a. Updated restrooms and new concessions stand
 - b. Multipurpose locker room for home/visiting team & football storage. Will include a small restroom and a small concession stand for the visiting side & room for athletic trainer. (No cost to taxpayers – part of grant)
 - c. Press box & bleachers for baseball & soccer field
 - d. New concession stand at end of gym that can also be used for baseball and soccer.
 - e. Fix cross country course.
 - f. Oil memorabilia & commemorative park area near oil derrick to make it an educational area. (Funded through donations / commemorative bricks – April 15th deadline)
 - g. Football merger w/ Cranberry – applied for in D9 and 10; D9 has already turned it down procedurally b/c it was not done by November 15th; D10 probably will also but we may win it on appeal. If AC valley co-ops with someone else or decides not to have a team then it will be approved right away b/c it won't change their classification from AA to A.
2. Deb B. reminded the group that the second annual Volleyball tournament is this Saturday.
3. The date for the fundraising dinner for baseball was changed to April 10th in the HS cafeteria.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:14 PM (1st Charlotte L., 2nd Paul S.)
The next meeting will be held on May 12th at 6:30 PM in the HS cafeteria.
