

Blue & White Boosters Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, July 14, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM by the President, Bill S. The golf coach, Steve Hensler, and soccer coach, Joanna Bigos, were introduced to the group and welcomed to the meeting.

Approval of the minutes of the May 12, 2010 meeting was tabled as there were not enough copies for everyone to read.

Treasurer's Report

Ray S. gave the year-end Financial Report. The cash currently in the bank is \$101,677 while the total dollars committed for the 2010-11 year is \$80,794. This leaves \$20,883 for unforeseen expenses (if needed).

The 2010-11 Coaches' Sports Budget was unveiled, and Bill S. explained the process used to determine the allotments. In order to keep some money in reserve, we arrived at the amount of \$38,000 to be distributed by taking 80% of the money raised last year (\$47K), based on the coaches' requests and money carried over.

Fundraising Report

\$100 raffle – the tickets are printed; the committee is working on how best to distribute them. They do have a list of ticket buyers from last year and will call if there are unsold tickets. The first home football game is Sept. 17th.

Fall Candle Sale – inquired at Our Own Candle Company and found that you do have to do Fall and Spring sales to get all of the different scents. The committee (tennis, golf, swimming) will meet & discuss this and the possibility of other companies.

Old Business

The Fall Sports Program committee has met once already and has decided to try some new things this year like coupon pages.

The Golf Program will continue to be run by Coach Hensler, and he will be working with B&W .

New Business

A motion was made by Larry E. and seconded by Cindy B. to approve the 2010-11 Oiler Football Team Fundraisers. These include the Lift-a-Thon, Men's Flag Football, 16& up Flag Football Tournament, and Powder Puff Football.

Girls Soccer Camp is being run as a free clinic for 6-8th grade. Coach Bigos would like to do more clinics in the winter and spring as fundraisers.

The Lil' Drillers had asked the school district to "attach" to them in order to obtain grant money that would be unavailable on their own. They were pointed in the direction of B&W. If they were admitted, they would have to turn their finances over to the club, would have a budget, and would have to participate in fundraisers. B&W was originally set up as a 9-122 organization, so the possibility of them being "under" the football program was raised. (Matt L. not present to discuss.)

The Swim Team coach is making plans to have college coaches come to hold half-day or day-long clinics over Christmas break. There may be a small fee involved to pay for the coaches' time and expenses.

Wrestling asked that they be allowed to do Pizza Hut and Hoss's fundraisers with dates to be determined. A motion to approve the fundraisers was made by Joe C. and seconded by Leon K.
